

Tiny Art Gallery Group Exhibition

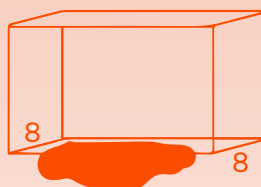
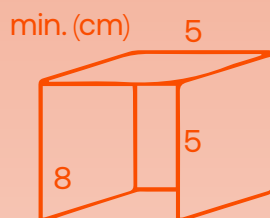

Our aim is to bring together local and international artists, working with different media from printmaking to animation and sculpture. Contrary to previous editions of The Tiny Art Gallery, the structure of the gallery itself will be a link to Bulgarian architecture by letting the artists make their own 'rooms' that will eventually form one „blok“ 'building'.

open call application info

- Apply with a concept for a tiny artwork
- Deadline **27.02.2023**
- 10 International, 10 local artists, total 20.
- All participating artists will get a fee of € 40,-
- Shipping costs will be covered
- All artworks should be shipped (more info if you get selected)



..Your room should stay within these sizes, but can be horizontal or landscape or oval from the

inside or arched etc.... but should always be 8 cm deep.

submission requirements

Every participating artist is asked to not only make a little work but also provide the little room the work is in. This allows the artist to work more 'spacious' and in detail, and let your biggest art dreams come true in a tiny version; You can place your work in a white cube, your grandma's living room, on a balcony, a rooftop, under water, in a cave. You name it! The world is yours except for a couple of specific requirements:

- **Dimensions:**
This room can be any size between min 5x5 and max 17x20 cm and should always be 8 cm deep (excl. a balcony or 'open' windows, these are extra)
- **Material:**
It can be any material as long as it has 2 or more solid and flat walls (so we can build a structure with it).
- **Artwork:**
Your rooms should be within these measurements, but the works displayed in them can be as tiny, or it can overflow the room.
